



JOB OFFER: TRANSFER TECHNICIAN FLUXPYR

The Laboratory of Functional Ecology and Global Change from the Forest Technology Centre of Catalonia (Solsona) is looking for a candidate to work as “Transfer Technician” within the European Project FLUXPYR, “Trans-border network for the assessment and management of water, carbon and energy fluxes under climate change conditions in agricultural and grassland ecosystems in the Pyrenees”.

Funding is subject to obtaining a competitive grant from the “Subprograma Personal Técnico de Apoyo (MICINN-PTA)”, for which the CTFC will apply once the candidate is selected. The candidate is expected to contribute to the integration and synthesis of the results from the project, development of written material, including leaflets, web page contents, dissemination material for different publics, and reports and scientific publications. The person selected for this position will work for and from the CTFC, and will contribute to the dissemination of the results of the different partners involved in FLUXPYR.

The candidate should have a superior degree and have knowledge of and a deep interest for environmental issues, have good English and Spanish written and oral levels (and if possible knowledge of Catalan and French), and have strong communication skills.

Contract duration: 1 to 3 years.
